Engineering News-Record, one of the industry's most authoritative publications, ranked Jacobs No. 1 in its list of Top 500 Design Firms for a fourth consecutive year. Widely considered the industry benchmark, the annual list ranks both publicly and privately held U.S. companies, based on revenue for design-specific services performed in the previous year.

2020 was a year like no other, but despite the many challenges and uncertainties, ENR's report shows that on the whole, design firms performed better than expected with the aggregate revenue for listed firms rising 1.48% to a record \$104.77 billion in 2020. Jacobs has held a top five spot in the Top 500 list since ENR's rankings began in 2003 and have held the No. 1 position for four consecutive years.

Some highlights from 2020 include working in partnership with the public and private sectors to support the retrofitting and design of COVID-19 vaccine manufacturing facilities; assessing and commissioning COVID-19 alternate care facilities; providing location-aware technology and automated intelligence for contact tracing; managing the design and construction of COVID-19 test facilities; supporting healthcare operations planning in the U.S., U.K., Australia and New Zealand; assisting with assessment and deployment of critical supplies (PPE and ventilators); and developing an innovative testing program to monitor COVID-19 spread in community wastewater streams.
