How long is a standard workshop?

Depending on the maturity and complexity of your organisation's existing strategy or opportunity, sessions can range from two hours to a full-day workshop.

Who will be involved?

We also welcome your technical teams who have a strong understanding of your emissions footprint – including asset management and operational personnel.
