


Configure ProjectWise Explorer


1. Start ProjectWise Explorer
2. Select the **Tools** menu




3. Select **Network Configuration Settings** (this may require assistance by the IT team from your company)



4. Tick **Prevent UDP** and untick both **IPv6** tick boxes.




5. Select the **DNS Services** tab



6. Tick **Prevent UDP**

7. Enter the fields as per the table below for the site required, you may need to choose the Run as administrator in the lower left corner to enter the configuration (example shown is for Jacobs Americas)
8. Click the **Add** button
9. Repeat steps 7 and 8 if multiple sites are required

10. Select the Datasource Listing tab



11. Tick **Prevent UDP**


12. Enter the fields as per the table below for the site required (example shown is for Jacobs Americas)

13. Click the **Add** button

14. Repeat steps 12 and 13 if multiple sites are required

15. Click the **Save** button

16. Click the **Close** button



17. Restart ProjectWise Explorer

18. If there are Jacobs Datasources listed in the left panel under the **ProjectWise Explorer Datasources** node you can proceed to [Login](#) or if they are not listed try the [self-help](#) support options.
