CITY OF CENTENNIAL, COLORADO

Since 2008, Jacobs has provided the City of Centennial with comprehensive public works services. FLORIDA TURNPIKE ENTERPRISE, FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

We provide maintenance operations and serve as the general engineering consultant to support Florida's Turnpike Enterprise. Staff maintain more than 480 centerline miles of roadway, 200 toll plaza buildings and operate two traffic management centers. Additionally, we operate the Emergency Operations Center and provide planning, preparation and response and recovery when hurricanes impact the Turnpike System.

CITY OF PEACHTREE CORNERS, GEORGIA

In 2013, the City of Peachtree Corners partnered with Jacobs to startup the first public services to be offered by the new City. Today, Jacobs supports 44,000 residents by providing public works, including roads, stormwater, code enforcement, planning and zoning, land development, building permitting and inspections, and smart city solutions. In recent years, Jacobs partnered with the City and Qualcomm to deploy an economic development initiative that installed cellular-vehicle-to-everything technology to support traffic management and roadside safety along a major collector road that serves the City's primary business district.
